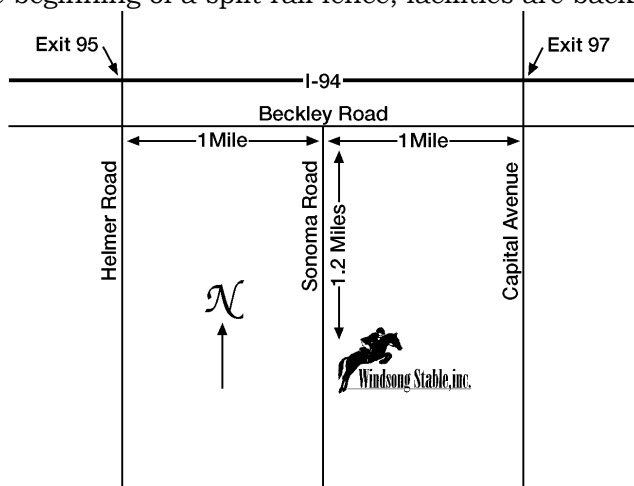

Directions to Windsong

I-94 to Capital Ave Exit #97. Turn south off the ramp. (If you are coming from the West, turn right off the ramp, you are on Beckley Road) At stop light turn right onto Beckley Rd. Go One mile to Sonoma Rd and turn left (South). Windsong is 1.2 miles down, on the left side of the road. Driveway is at the beginning of a split rail fence, facilities are back off the road.

- * Entry Fees \$18 per class Medals \$20
- Entries close Wednesday, August 4, 2010
- Please include a copy of your MHJA card, horse nomination and pony measurement card with your entry blank.
- * EMT Fee \$6 per horse/rider combination
- Stall Fees: \$60.00 per stall. No bedding provided. *No stall refunds.*
- Non Showing horses will be charged \$40 in addition to stall fee.
- Stabling is in wooden temporary stalls in the indoor arena.
Call to order shavings at \$5.00 per bag.
- You must send a check to guarantee your stall reservation!**
- * Camper space is available - first pay = first reservations \$60/weekend
- * Ribbons to sixth place. First Place Prizes!
- * Division Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons.
- * A concession stand will be open during the horse show.
- * All riders must wear ASTM SEI approved helmets while mounted.
- * Please leave your dogs at home!
- * EMT on duty during the show.
- * ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING in barns, arena, lounge or tent.
- * All classes shall follow the USEF or MHJA rules.
- * Management reserves the right to divide, cancel or combine classes as entries warrant.

MHJA RULES and REGULATIONS

- * All fees, MHJA numbers and signatures must accompany entry blank, or an open check must be left with entry blank.
- * No horse shall show in any class at a recognized MHJA show if it has been given any forbidden substance.
- * In order to accumulate points in any MHJA division, the horse must be recorded with the MHJA. Owners in hunter divisions and all equitation riders must be current members of the MHJA for points to count. Memberships may be applied for at the show, with the show secretary. Riders must be members to ride in MHJA Medal classes.

- * **Primary Hunter** (Adult section and Junior section)
Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any Hunter classes. Competing in classes 2'9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences 2'3"
- * **Primary Equitation** (Adult section and Junior section)
Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons in any Equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation on the flat classes do not affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation over fences classes do affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation on the flat classes. Competing in classes 2'9" or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences 2'3"
- * **Intermediate Hunter** (Adult section and Junior section)
Open to riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any hunter classes. Competing in classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences 2'6"
- * **Intermediate Equitation** (Adult section and Junior section)
Open to riders who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any equitation classes. Ribbons won in Equitation on the flat classes do not affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation over fences classes. However, ribbons won in Equitation over fences classes do affect a rider's eligibility in Equitation on the flat classes. Competing in classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences 2'6"
- * **Intermediate Medal**
Open to current MHJA Members, who have not won 9 blue ribbons in any equitation classes. Competing in classes 3' or higher will make a rider immediately ineligible to compete in this division. Fences 2'6" Tests allowed : 1-8
- * **Beginner Hunter** (Adult section and Junior section)
Open to riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in recognized hunter classes prior to October 1st of the preceding year, but do retain their beginner status for the show year. This division is not open to any rider's who have shown in any Open divisions. Rider's having won in the Beginner division will not lose their Novice or Primary status. Riders may NOT cross enter into classes that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Fences 2' No oxers or in and outs
- * **Beginner Equitation** (Adult section and Junior Hunter)
Open to riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in recognized equitation classes prior to October 1st of the preceding year, but do retain their beginner status for the show year. This division is not open to any rider's who have shown in any Open divisions. Rider's having won in the Beginner division will not lose their Novice or Primary status. Riders may NOT cross enter into classes that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Fences 2' No oxers or in and outs
- * **Junior/Adult Mini Medal**
Open to Junior and Adult riders who have not won 3 blue ribbons in recognized Equitation classes at MHJA, MHSA or USEF shows prior to Oct 1 of preceding year. Riders do retain their status for the current show season. Riders having won do not lose their Novice, Primary or Short Stirrup status. This class is not open to any riders who have shown in any Open Hunter or Equitation divisions at MHJA, MHSA or USEF Pony or Regular Member shows. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that require jumping 2'6" or higher. Jumping 2'6" or higher will make the rider IMMEDIATELY ineligible for this division. The top 15 point accumulators in this class during the season, will qualify to compete in the Medal Finals. Fences 2'

MHJA PONY HUNTER RECOGNIZED DIVISIONS

Pony Hunter Open to ponies of any age, ridden by a Junior. All ponies, entered in a pony class, must possess a current measurement card.

Small Pony - not to exceed 12.2 hands. No rider over 12 years of age may compete on a small pony. Fences 2'

Medium Pony - not to exceed 13.2 hands. No rider over 14 years of age may compete on a medium pony. Fences 2'3"

Large pony - not to exceed 14.2 hands. Fences 2'9"

Children's Pony Hunter Open to Junior riders who have not won three blue ribbons over fences in hunter classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member Shows. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized hunter classes at USEF shows. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup or Novice Pony Hunter divisions do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. No in and outs.

Children's small/medium Pony Hunter Fences 2'

Children's large Pony Hunter Fences 2'6"

Novice Pony Hunter Open to Junior riders who have not shown in any open hunter or equitation divisions at MHJA or USEF Pony or Regular Member show. Open divisions include: MHJA Pony and USEF Medals, Small, Medium & Large Pony Hunters, Pony Equitation 12 & under and 13 thru 17, MHJA Open Junior Medal and USEF Medals. These riders may not have won 3 blue ribbons in Hunter classes at any MHJA Pony or Regular member show.

Riders having won in the Novice Pony Hunter division do not lose their Children's Pony Hunter status. No in and outs, no oxers

Novice Small/Medium/Large Pony Hunter Fences 2'

Short Stirrup Pony Hunter Open to Junior riders 11 years of age and under. These riders may not have won nine blue ribbons over fences in a recognized equitation class at MHJA or USEF shows, prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the entire show year. Riders may not have shown in open hunter or equitation divisions (see Novice Pony Hunter). SS riders may not ride in the Children's Pony Hunter or Eq division. Riders having won in the Short Stirrup division do not lose their Maiden or Novice status. No in and outs. No oxers.

MHJA PONY EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Pony Equitation 12 years and under Open to Junior riders 12 years and under, mounted on ponies. Tests #1-9 over fences; #1-5, 8,9 flat classes

Large Ponies Fences 2'9"

Medium Ponies Fences 2'3"

Small Ponies Fences 2'

Pony Equitation 13 - 17 years Open to Junior riders 13 - 17 years of age, mounted on ponies. Tests # 1-9 over fences; #1-5,8,9 flat classes

Large Ponies Fences 2'9"

Medium Ponies Fences 2'3"

Small Ponies Fences 2'

Children's Pony Equitation Open to Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won three blue ribbons over fences in equitation classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup or Novice Pony Equitation divisions do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF shows. No in and outs. No tests

Children's Small/Medium Pony Equitation Fences 2'

Children's Large Pony Equitation Fences 2'6"

Novice Pony Equitation Open to Junior riders, mounted on ponies, who have not won three blue ribbons in Equitation classes at MHJA Pony or Regular Member shows. Ribbons won in the Short Stirrup Division do not affect a rider's eligibility for this division. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized equitation classes at USEF shows.

No in and outs. No tests

Novice Small/Med/Large Pony Equitation Fences 2'

Short Stirrup Pony Equitation Open to Junior riders 11 years of age and under. These riders may not have won nine blue ribbons over fences in a recognized equitation class at MHJA or USEF shows, prior to October 1st of the preceding year. Riders do retain their Short Stirrup status for the entire show year. Riders may not have shown in open hunter or equitation divisions (see Novice Pony Hunter). SS riders may not ride in the Children's Pony Hunter or Eq division. Riders having won in the Short Stirrup division do not lose their Maiden or Novice status. No in and outs No oxers No tests

Short Stirrup Small/Medium Pony Equitation Fences 18"

Short Stirrup Large Pony Hunter Fences 2'

MHJA Pony Medal Open to current MHJA Junior riders mounted on ponies Tests 1-19 (Rule XIV)

Large Fences 2'9"

Medium Fences 2'3"

Small Fences 2'

MHJA Pony Mini Medal Open to current MHJA Junior riders mounted on ponies. Riders may not have won three blue ribbons in eq classes at any MHJA Pony or Regular member show. In addition, riders may not have won 15 points in recognized eq classes at any USEF shows. Winning 15 points will make a rider ineligible for this class. It is NOT open to riders who have competed in MHJA Small, Medium or Large Pony Hunter classes, Pony Eq 11 & under, Pony Eq 12-17, or Pony Medal. Riders MAY NOT cross enter into any of those divisions. Ribbons won in short stirrup or Novice pony eq classes DO NOT affect a rider's eligibility in this class.

No in and outs No oxers Tests 1-8 2'0 for all riders
